#### **Arab SME Summit**

(Amman, 30 October–1 November 2022)

Under the patronage of Crown Prince AI Hussein bin Abdullah II, ESCWA held the first Arab SME Summit at the Kempinski Convention Centre in Amman from 30 October to 1 November 2022, on the theme "Opportunities beyond borders". The Summit aimed to provide new opportunities for small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in the Arab region to expand and position themselves for future progress and growth, and to access regional and international markets.

The Summit brough together around 650 participants, including policymakers, entrepreneurs, investors, business influencers, economists, journalists, intergovernmental organizations, non-governmental





organizations and donors. At the close of the Summit, ESCWA announced its partners' commitment to provide funding to SMEs to the tune of \$130 million.

### **Restoring Hope challenge**

The closing ceremony of the first Arab SME Summit, held on 1 November 2022, provided an opportunity to present awards to the winners of the Restoring Hope challenge, which ESCWA launched in early 2022. The challenge aimed to identify innovative ideas that could help millions of people across the Arab region to reclaim hope in their societies, restore belief in a dignified and prosperous future, and revive their will to assume a role in shaping that future.

The winners are Yasmein Ali Abdelghany from Egypt and Eliane El Haber from Lebanon, with their idea "244 Lights of Hope". The concept of this mental health assistance idea is based on the shared human need

to accept wounds, learn to cope with them, and strive for healing.

### **Startups Facing Hardship challenge**



In the summer of 2022, we asked you to tell the story of your company. What difficulties did you face during the founding and development of your

enterprise, and how did you overcome them? From all the submissions, we were able to choose one lucky winner, **iRole**, founded by Sawsan Lubani.

iRole is the first integrated platform in the Arab region that focuses on empowering women in the world of work as freelancers or remote workers, by connecting them with remote job opportunities. It provides key employment skills and self-development online courses and tools, and connects women with educational and professional opportunities worldwide.

# eCommerce Acceleration Programme

In December 2022, ESCWA launched the second eCommerce Acceleration Programme (eCAP), with the support of the ICC-ESCWA Centre of Entrepreneurship, to empower Arab SMEs through their transition journey into online selling.

eCAP aims to build the capacity of up to 100 SMEs from the Arab region to transition into online selling, either by developing their transactional e-commerce websites or by selling on existing online marketplaces. Participating SMEs will benefit from business and technical expertise, critical setup assistance to build/optimize their online platforms or sell on existing virtual marketplaces, one-on-one coaching, and exposure and access to networking opportunities.



Eligible SMEs must:

- · Be registered and operational in an Arab country.
- Have a working product or service that can be sold online.
- Have an online presence on social media or an existing website.
- Be willing to dedicate one or two team members to the project.

The online application form is available in <u>Arabic</u> and English.

Deadline for applications is 28 February 2023.
